## **Leadership roles**

**Volunteer Coordinator** – We can't fulfill our mission of "getting out the vote" without volunteers. We need someone who can work independently and is good with people. We need someone who will actively recruit, train and supervise volunteers. The Volunteer Coordinator will report to the County Chair.

**Fundraising Coordinator** - Are you good at asking for people to donate money or services? Do you have great ideas for new and unique fundraising events? If so, we need you. The Fundraising Chair will plan events and carry them out. This will include supervising volunteers, overseeing money collection and working with the Treasurer. The Fundraising Chair will report to the County Chair.

**Voter Contact Coordinator** – As part of our "Get Out the Vote" mission we contact a lot of voters. We use texting, postcards, mailouts, phone banks, blockwalking etc. We need a person who coordinates all of these efforts and makes sure they are effective and efficient. There will be a lead person for each kind of voter contact and they will report to the Voter Contact Coordinator.. The VCC will report to the County Chair.

**Lead for Texting, Lead for Postcards, Lead for Mailouts, Lead for Phone Banks, Lead for Blockwalking** – We need one person to be the lead for each kind of communication. You may be the lead for more than one if you wish. This person will coordinate with Precinct Chairs and the County Chair to organize our various voter contact efforts. The Lead person will report to the Voter Contact Coordinator.

**Precinct Chairs** – The Precinct Chairs help the Chair with the "Get Out The Vote" efforts, help set KCDP policy and work with the people in their precinct. We also need Deputy Precinct Chairs for all precincts. If you don't know what precinct you are in, call or stop by the office and we'll check. Precincts we need chairs for are

## **Worker Roles**

**Texting** – Take the Texting training then answer texts from voters using the Scale To Win software. Report to Texting Lead.

**Phone Banking** – Take the phone banking training then call voters to ask them to vote or other prompts. You will need a computer for this. We will have phone banks at the office, but this can also be done at home. Report to Phone banking Lead.

**Blockwalking** – You will walk in pairs to knock on Democrats doors only. You will talk to them about voting, etc. Report to Blockwalking Lead.

**Office Workers** – Can you volunteer six hours a week to keep the office open? The hours are from 11:00 am to 2:00 pm. You would answer the phone, help voters that come to the office, assist in projects going on etc. You would report to the Office Manager

**Market Days** – BAD and KCDP have a booth at Market Days several times a year. We would like to increase that. The Republicans have one every month. Can you sign up for a three hour shift to staff the booth? There are many Democrats who stop by and are happy to see us there. Talk to Susan Dollar about volunteering at Market Days
